The 2020 University Admission process is based solely the applicant's baccalaureate grade average for all undergraduate study programmes and faculties (*The Faculty of Physical Education and Sport, Design, Theology, Exact Sciences and Educational Sciences require additional, field related, tests*).

Place confirmation:
Within 3 days of the final admission list being published, all admitted students must confirm their place:

Required application documents:

1. Application form (received upon applying),
2. Baccalaureate Diploma (original) or equivalent document;
3. Transcript of records (copy and original);
4. Birth certificate (copy and original);
5. Marriage certificate (if applicable, copy and original);
6. ID (copy);
7. Medical certificate;
8. 2 photos (ID sized);
9. File folder.

- a) If they haven't already, students admitted for government subsidized places must lodge their original baccalaureate diploma with the initial admission committee and pay a 100 RON matriculation fee at the university's cash office.
- b) Self-funded students must pay a 100 RON matriculation fee, as well as 25% of the tuition fee.

Provisional admission list: 27th July
Appeals: 28th July
Place confirmation: 29-31 July
Final admission list: 31st July

Second session - September 2020
Application period: 01-10 September 2020
Provisional admission list: 10th September 2020
Appeals: 11th of September
Place confirmation: 14-17 September 2020
Final admission list: 17th September
