1. THE MISSION OF THE STUDY PROGRAM

The master's degree program **INTERACTIVE PEDAGOGY**, as an integral part of the educational offer of the Faculty of Educational Sciences, Psychology and Social Work, represents an important institutional structure for the initial training of teachers in pre-university education (level 2-Bologna system). This program is centered on the training of specialists, professionals recognized in the nomenclature of professions, experts in the field of educational sciences, in a rigorous formal framework, scientifically grounded and with high applicative relevance.

The master's degree program INTERACTIVE PEDAGOGY is addressed to graduates of bachelor's studies in the field of educational sciences, as well as to graduates of other bachelor's programs with a didactic profile, ensuring the formation of skills of interactive approach to the educational phenomenon, of designing, organizing and carrying out activities specific to the field of studies, based on the fundamental values and ethical principles of the profession.

The professionalization in the teaching career, in a global vision, starts from multidimensional approaches from the social sphere, research and psycho-pedagogical practice, focusing on the formation of specific and transversal competences, in the design, implementation and regulation of the didactic act. The master's degree program meets the requirements of integrating research with educational praxis, in the initial and continuous training of educators of all levels.

The program offers the opportunity for interactive learning experiences, in the context of a real teacher-student partnership, in accordance with the new development perspectives of university education in the European context. The designed curriculum starts from the real needs of the educational actors, identified through a series of psycho-pedagogical and managerial researches. The applicative dimension of the program is conferred by the pedagogical internships, the increased insertion on the labor market and the internationalization of the program, thus ensuring its European dimensions.

2. OBJECTIVES OF THE STUDY program

The master's degree program INTERACTIVE PEDAGOGY aims to:

- O1 Training of experts in the field of education, through professional development;
- O2 ensuring the expertise of teachers for the organization of teaching activities in education;
- O3 training and advanced development of the capacity to design, organize and carry out teaching activities in the spirit of interactivity;
- O4 development of the set of competences for promoting the specific techniques of critical thinking and interactive ones, for building programs on professional development;
- O5 the creation of competence bases regarding the involvement in human resources development projects in the field of education.

- The number of hours of practice, tutoring and practice for the elaboration of the dissertation is 98 hours

8. CONDITIONS FOR ENROLLMENT IN THE NEXT ACADEMIC YEAR. CONDITIONS FOR PASSING ONE YEAR OF STUDIES. RETURN CONDITIONS

The conditions for enrollment in the next academic year, the conditions for promotion and those for return are contained in the ECTS Regulation and in the Regulation on the professional activity of students based on transferable credits

To pass in the following year of study, students must obtain a minimum number of credits, as follows:

- a) In order to move from the first year of studies to the second year, the student must obtain at least 30 credits:
- b) In order to move from the second year to the third year, the student must accumulate at the end of the second year of studies at least 90 credits obtained in the first year and the second year in total;
- c) In order to move from the third year to the fourth year, the student must accumulate at the end of the third year of studies at least 150 credits obtained in the first year, the second year and the third year in total;
- d) In order to register for the bachelor's degree exam, the student must obtain at least 240 credits (minimum 60 credits from each year of studies);
- e) In order to be considered promoted, a student must be integralist, i.e. to obtain all the study credits provided in the curriculum for the respective year of studies and to obtain a grade or passing grade in the subjects that are not provided with credits;

Students who do not meet the minimum criteria provided in paragraph 1 letter a-c. will be expelled at the end of the respective academic year. These students will be able to be re-enrolled at the beginning of the following academic year in the same year of studies from which they were expelled

Students who during an academic year (2 semesters of the same year of study) do not accumulate the minimum number of credits, established by the Faculty Council necessary for the student's transition from one year of study to the next, will be declared postponed and will be recorded in the matriculation register "postponed to obtain all credits for the respective year(s) of study". The deferral of one year of study can be granted a maximum of 3 academic years for the entire period of study. The study of the subjects not passed is resumed, redoing the entire teaching activity for them.

The student who, at the end of the studies, after completing the number of semesters (years of studies) provided in the curriculum for the duration of the studies, has not fully completed his/her school obligations and has a maximum of five arrears from the last four semesters, may request the extension of the schooling (with fee), by 1 - 2 semesters in order to make up the outstanding study subjects.

9. DISSERTATION EXAM

The conditions for taking the dissertation exam are contained in the Methodology for organizing and conducting the final exams.

- Communication of the dissertation theme: October
- Period of elaboration of the dissertation thesis: semester III/ semester IV
- Dissertation exam period: July 2024
- The final exam consists of: the defense of the dissertation

The completion of the educational process is carried out by the master's students by developing a dissertation under the scientific supervision of the specialized teachers. The completion of the master's studies is achieved through the public defense by the graduates of the dissertation in front of a specialized committee.
