Style Guidelines for Conference Papers: page format – standard-sized page (A4) with all page margins – 2,0; font – Times New Roman, font size – 14, single space, first line indent – 1,25. **The author's full name** appears in bold, font size – 14, right align. Single spacing is followed by the author's *research degree and title indication (in case there is any)*. *Position, institutional affiliation, location and the author's e-mail address* appear in italics. The **PAPER TITLE** is **CAPITALISED** and appears in **BOLD** (central alignment) in English. An **Abstract** comprising 4-5 sentence (font size – 12) should follow. **Keywords** should include about 3-5 terms (font size – 12) in English and appear in italics, central alignment. The main body of the paper follows double spacing. It is coupled with **References** (the list of alphabetically arranged sources; for in-text citation please use square page brackets). The submitted paper should contain 1-3 pages. The conference paper comprises **Introduction** (topicality, problem statement); **Aim of the Study, Methods and Approaches; Results, and Conclusion**. publishing the monograph "The Unified Open Information Space in Life-long Education: Obstacles, Realities, Strategies" (the deadline for submission is **31/06/2021**).

Style Guidelines for Monograph articles (chapters): page format – standard-sized page (A4) with all page margins – 2,0; font – Times New Roman, font size – 14; 1,5 spacing; first line indent – 1,25; UDC index (the Universal Decimal Classification index) – left align. 1,5 space is followed by the author's ORCID ID and e-mail address. The author's full **name** follows in bold (central alignment), The author's research degree and title indication (in case there is any); position, institutional affiliation and location follow a 1,5 spacing. The **Paper Title** appears in bold in English (central alignment). An **abstract** including 4-5 sentences and coupled with 3-5 **Keywords** in English appears in italics, central alignment. The main body of the paper follows a double spacing. It is coupled with **References** (the list of sources arranged alphabetically; for in-text citation use square page brackets and the APA style for your **References**). An author's chapter of the monograph (article) should contain 15-20 pages. The monograph article (chapter) comprises the **Research Topicality** (Introduction, problem statement); **Literature Review, Aim of the Study; Methods and Approaches; Results and Discussion; Conclusion and Prospects for Further Research, References**, and a list of **Transliterated References**. To see how to structure the monograph article, please take a look at **Appendix B**.

3. Financing. Participation Fees:

- for foreign authors – € 30 including organisation and correspondence expenses, e-certificate issue (1 ECTS – 30 hours), and the e-compendium of the Forum materials issue.

For the authors interested in contributing to the monograph (the expenses are added to the basic participation fees after the author's article (chapter) has been reviewed and accepted by the editorial board):

- for Ukrainian authors – 550 ₴ UAH (layout provision, a scholarly review, editing, publication and printing the monograph). **Attention!** Pages exceeding the limit are calculated as the equivalent of 50 ₴ UAH per page. These expenses are added to the basic participation fees.
- for foreign authors – €100 (layout provision, scholarly peer review, editing, publishing the monograph in the electronic format). **Attention!** Pages exceeding the limit are calculated as the equivalent of €20 per page. These expenses are added to the basic participation fees.

Payment details are provided after the organising committee has included the topic of the report (conference paper) into the programme and the editorial board has reviewed and accepted the paper. The editorial board is due to notify the author via e-mail (by the e-mail address provided in the course of e-registration).
