

Publication Ethics and Editorial Best Practices

The “Aurel Vlaicu” University of Arad Publishing House (UAV Publishing House) promotes high standards of scientific quality and academic integrity in all its publications. The editorial process is carried out in accordance with the principles of research ethics and good academic conduct, ensuring transparency, objectivity, and mutual respect among authors, reviewers, and editors.

1. General Principles

UAV Publishing House is committed to respecting and promoting the following principles:

- **Scientific integrity:** all published works must reflect authentic research results, without falsification, fabrication, or manipulation of data.
- **Originality:** manuscripts must be original and must not have been previously published or simultaneously submitted for evaluation to other publishers.
- **Transparency:** authors are required to declare any potential conflicts of interest and acknowledge any financial or institutional support received.
- **Respect for copyright:** proper citation of sources and the avoidance of plagiarism are mandatory conditions for the acceptance of manuscripts.

2. Authors' Responsibilities

Authors must:

- submit original works written in accordance with scientific and citation standards;
- ensure the accuracy of the data and sources used;
- acknowledge any significant contribution made by other individuals;
- respect the confidentiality of data and the rights of participants (where applicable);
- cooperate promptly during the review and proofreading process.

3. Editors' Responsibilities

Editors of UAV Publishing House:

- ensure the objective evaluation of manuscripts exclusively on the basis of scientific merit and academic relevance;
- maintain the confidentiality of submitted materials;
- avoid any conflicts of interest between author, reviewer, and editor;
- commit to rejecting or retracting works in cases of plagiarism, duplicate publication, or falsified data.

4. Review Process

All manuscripts are subject to a **scientific evaluation process (peer review)** conducted by independent experts in the relevant field.

The evaluation is carried out under a **double-blind review system** (authors and reviewers remain anonymous to each other), and the final decision belongs to the **Editorial Board**.

5. Plagiarism Policy

UAV Publishing House uses electronic tools for verifying the originality of submitted texts (**anti-plagiarism software**). Works identified as containing plagiarized or self-plagiarized content are rejected, and the authors may be institutionally notified.

6. Retraction of Publications

The publishing house reserves the right to retract a publication if major errors, incorrect data, or violations of academic ethics are discovered. Retractions are publicly announced, with the reason clearly stated.

7. Alignment with International Standards

The editorial policy of UAV Publishing House follows the principles and recommendations established by:
